Cusop Parish Council Clerk's Report, May 2022

- 1. Herefordshire Local Plan. The council's comments have been acknowledged.
- 2. 3.
- **4.** Clerk recruitment. Putting the advert onto various local Facebook pages resulted in several excellent applications.
- 5. Wye Local. We have been offered an introductory piece on the new clerk.
- 6. Roads and footpaths. I am now reporting problems via the Herefordshire Council portal rather than via the Balfour Beatty Locality Steward. I did check whether the broken stile near Llydyadyway Farm might be a Highways responsibility, as it led from the road, but was told that it came under Herefordshire Council Public Rights of Way. As I had already reported it to them, I await their response.
- 7. Bookers Edge verge. I have asked Balfour Beatty to confirm what verges they are responsible for within the parish.
- 8. Church Road grit bin. I had informed Balfour Beatty about the collapsed grit bin, but it has now been righted by the Parish Contractor.
- **9. Hardwicke Road sign.** There is no money in the roads budget for its repair or replacement. Balfour Beatty have offered to remove it.
- **10. Audit.** The accounts are with the internal auditor, who will be completing the internal audit before the council's June meeting.
- **11. Resiting of bench.** Balfour Beatty have been reminded about the proposal to move the bench further up the Dingle.
- **12. Barn opposite Co Op.** I have repeated my request for Building Control to look into this. They have now been in touch, and are looking into it.
- **13. Bookers Edge verges.** These are to be cut by Herefordshire Council. I did not request two cuts at the start of the season, as I didn't know that Herefordshire Council had accepted responsibility for them, but have asked Balfour Beatty to stretch a point and cut them twice (along with Church Lane and Nantyglasdwr Lane.
- **14. Footpaths.** I have asked Sharon Marsh whether she can think of any improvements to be made to any footpaths.
- **15. Parish Contractor.** Planning to clear lower Dingle gutters and footpaths of weeds this week.
